

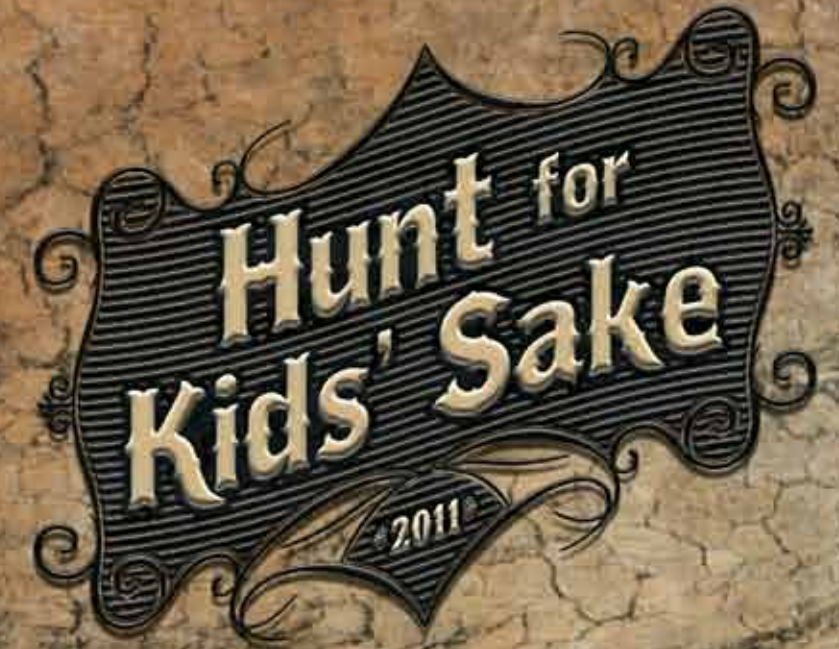

In Native American culture, dreamcatchers were hung as charms to protect sleeping children from nightmares.

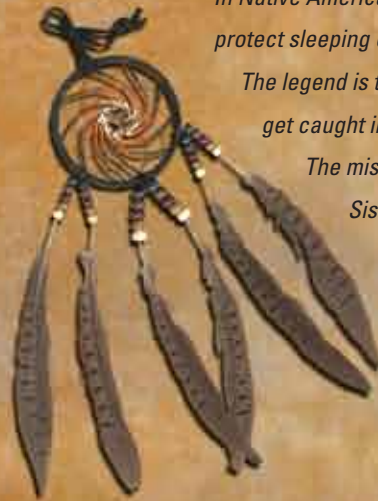
The legend is that the bad dreams will get caught in the web.
